CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Chairman Dean Spohn called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. Members present: Victor Berger and Alice Flyte. Professionals present: Solicitor, Colin Macfarlane; Engineer, Pete Eisenbrown; Administrator, Jane Werley; Road Master, Bobby Follweiler.

1. Motion made by AF to approve the Minutes of the July 5, 2022 Board of Supervisors Meeting. Seconded by DS. Motion carried 2-0.

2. Road Master – Awaiting confirmation from Steve Hoffman before ordering materials for the Sittler Valley Road Culvert Project. PennDot repaving Rt. 737 from the Greenwich Elementary School to

Maxatawny line. Drainage issue on Gensinger Rd. has been addressed with PennDot and H&K Group. Repairs will be made to correct the drainage issue.

3. Engineering and Zoning Reports – Discussion on long range plan to realign Long Lane Rd.
 - a. Motion made by VB authorizing the Township Engineer to contact stakeholders concerning realignment of Long Lane. Seconded by AF. Motion carried 3-0.
 - b. Motion made by AF to authorize the Township Administrator to contact Senator Argall and Representative Knowles office concerning realignment of Long Lane. Seconded by VB. Motion carried 3-0.
4. Zoning Reports – Colin will follow up with Zoning Officer on violations and Magistrate court dates.
5. Solicitor – Nothing to report.

1. Motion made by VB to approve the bills and accept the Treasurers Report. Seconded by AF. Motion carried 3-0.
