Mr. Spohn called the Greenwich Township Special Meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and asked everyone to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Fred Germann 1273 Krumsville Road, requested that Dodie Sable be removed from the Zoning Hearing Board because he believed that sound reports she submitted to the township were fraudulent and were provided to convince the township to spend money. Mr. Germann felt there needs to be a cross section of the community on the Board of Supervisors and discussed a past request for a storm water waiver that Supervisor Diehl voted against even though the township engineer was okay with the waiver. Mr. Spohn explained to Mr. Germann that we cannot force people to run for office and he and Mr. Diehl both ran unopposed. Mr. Germann asked why the change in engineers and listed the past three firms the township had for engineering. Mr. Spohn stated the Supervisors are doing what they feel is in the township's best interest. Mr. Germann spoke again about lateral permeability and the inadequate traffic study requirements. Mr. Berger stated that the township must follow the state regulations. Mr. Germann suggested the township challenge the state regulations.

NEW BUSINESS:

Driveway Permit Administrator

A motion was made by Mr. Berger, seconded by Mr. Spohn, to appoint Chris Noll of Keystone Engineering Consultants as driveway permit administrator. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Township Engineer

A motion was made by Mr. Spohn, seconded by Mr. Diehl, to appoint Systems Design Engineering, Inc. as the township engineer with Michael Bingham acting as primary engineer. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
