

Greenwich Township Board of Supervisors Special Meeting  
Monday, January 30, 2023, 7:00 p.m.

Attending: Supervisors: Dean Spohn, Victor Berger, and Diane Hollenbach-Administrator

Mr. Spohn called the Greenwich Township special meeting to order in the Greenwich Township Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. and asked everyone to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Mr. Diehl stated that he is a fifty year resident of the township having grown up on Kohlers Hill Road and later built his home on Hummels Hill Road. He has worked for the Borough of Kutztown for thirty-three years and has experience supervising his department for the last ten years. Mr. Diehl has attended many municipal meetings and has been involved in snow plow operations. What he does not know, he is willing to learn and work for all the township residents.

A motion was made by Victor Berger, seconded by Dean Spohn, to appoint Steven Diehl as Greenwich Township Supervisor with a term beginning on February 6, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023. All were in favor. Motion carried.
